VILLAGE HALL

The Committee will not get a certificate of lawfulness for the disabled access alterations at the present time; if necessary it will be applied for retrospectively.

David Hodgson is applying for a grant from TVBC to help with the cost of the ramp.

<u>Playground inspection</u> – A new volunteer has come forward to undertake the weekly checks of the playground – Shaun Burton-Pye. The Parish Council extend their thanks to him. ANDOVER AIRFIELD SITE: S106 Money

Katrina has written to David Gleave asking TVBC to confirm where the money has been allotted (approx £200,000). This information was not forthcoming but Katrina was told £50,000 was spent on training.
